Call for Papers on “Work-Based Learning” (with a focus on Level 5)

The *Journal of Pedagogic Development (JPD)* will publish a special issue on the subject of Work-Based Learning in November 2018. This special edition will be produced in association with Chain5.

We warmly invite you to submit your paper for consideration before **30 July 2018**, at which point it will be peer reviewed. Papers must be written in English. (Support is available for writers for whom English is a second or third language.) Papers between 2000 and 7000 words are preferred, but if you would like to propose something shorter or longer, or in a different format, please contact us to discuss it.

Following the themes of the Chain5 Seminar on Work-based Learning (University of Bedfordshire, November 2017), and the Annual Conference (Brussels, March 2018), we are interested in work-based learning in as broad a definition of the term as might be thought of. You might wish to discuss a project that you have worked on; you might be making strategic or institutional changes to incorporate work-based learning as a new initiative; perhaps you are concerned with Level 5, progression to Level 6, apprenticeships, dual higher education or many other linked scenarios. As long as your submission is connected with teaching, learning and/or pedagogy, we will be happy to consider it for publication.

The *JPD* is a fully peer reviewed journal with an international outlook. Teaching, learning and pedagogy are at the heart of the journal. Launched in 2011, we publish three times a year – March, July and November – in hard copy and online.
