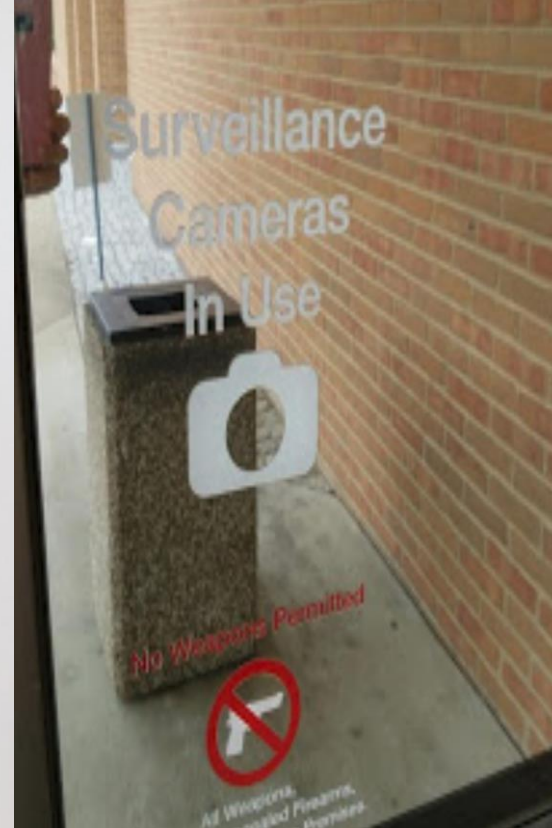
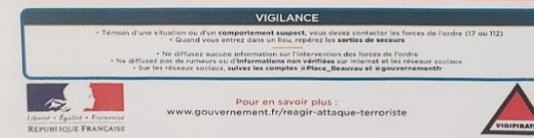

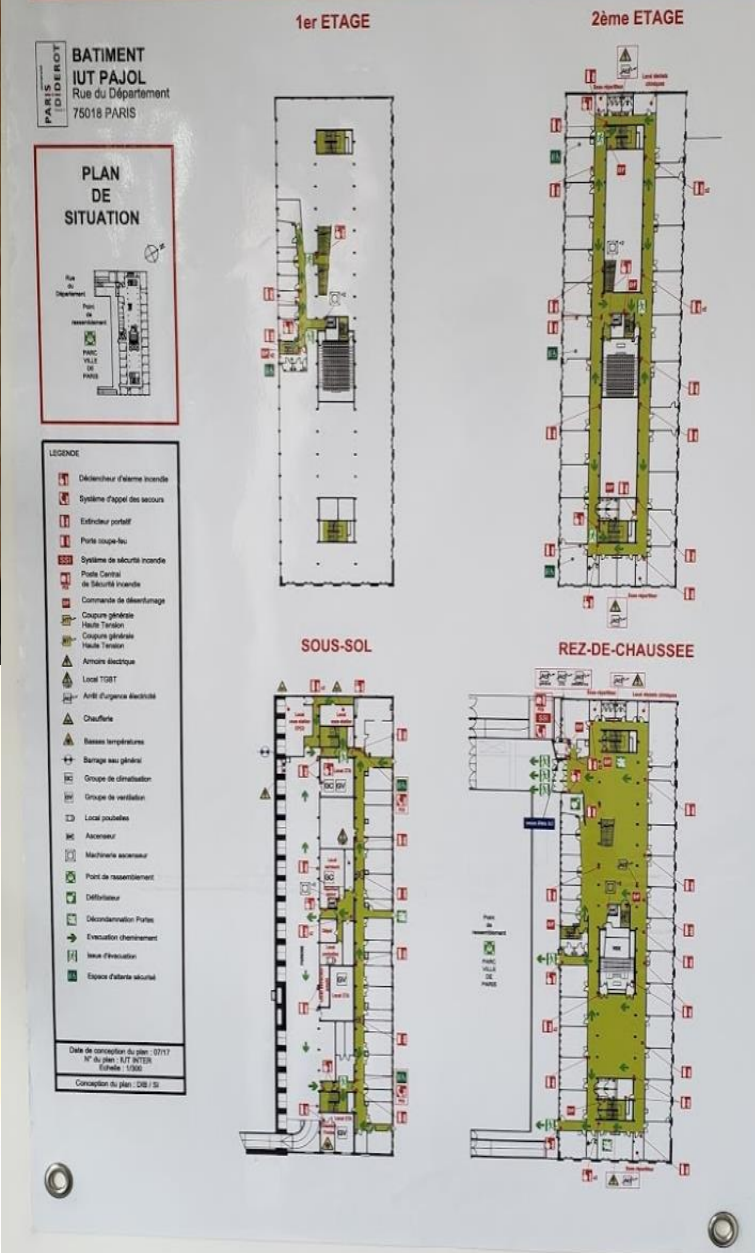

DATA SECURITY

EU Charter of Fundamental Rights

- Everyone has the right to:
 - The protection of personal data concerning him or her
 - Access to data which has been collected concerning him or her, and the right to have it rectified

“The right to be forgotten...”

Concerns from EU Higher Education

- Data storage laws contradict the “right to be forgotten”
- Challenges for international students
- Exchange of data for usage of internet

Right to be forgotten...

Individuals have the right:

- Know what companies are collecting personal data and how it is being used
- To remove or edit information that has been collected
- To know who within organizations is responsible for the oversight of data collective

- Strengthen enforcement of sexual harassment laws
- Empowering survivors
- Support research on the occurrence of sexual harassment

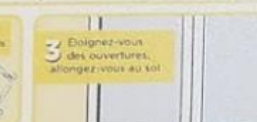
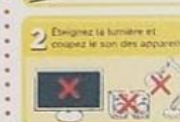
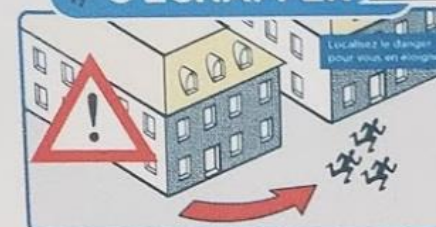
