EQF and ad-Educative Professional VET

Applies Theory

- Core: learning in practice
- Professional attitude: 'Me as a professional'
- Knowledge base: theory on teaching and learning, subject-matter knowledge
- Subject matter: Professional choice





EQF and ad-Educative Professional VET

Level 5: our 'translation'

- Task: the practice of workbased learning and classroom learning
- Knowledge base: pedagogy, didactics
- Works in different types of classrooms, one at a time
- Works under supervision of a teacher (bachelor or master)
- Stimulates deep-learning strategies
- 'Onderzoekend vermogen' (inquiry based) being inquisitive and methodic, micro level, provide strategies for solving problems in ones own classroom practice
- Coaching skills: dialogue





More specific

Systematic approach

Core task:

- Ad: teach in one setting, responsibility for micro-level
- Bc: teach in multiple settings, responsible for meso and macro-level
- Theory on teaching and learning
 - Pedagogy
 - Didactics



More specific

Teamwork

- Core task:
 - Ad: work with bc. On core task
 - Bc: manageing team on meso-level
