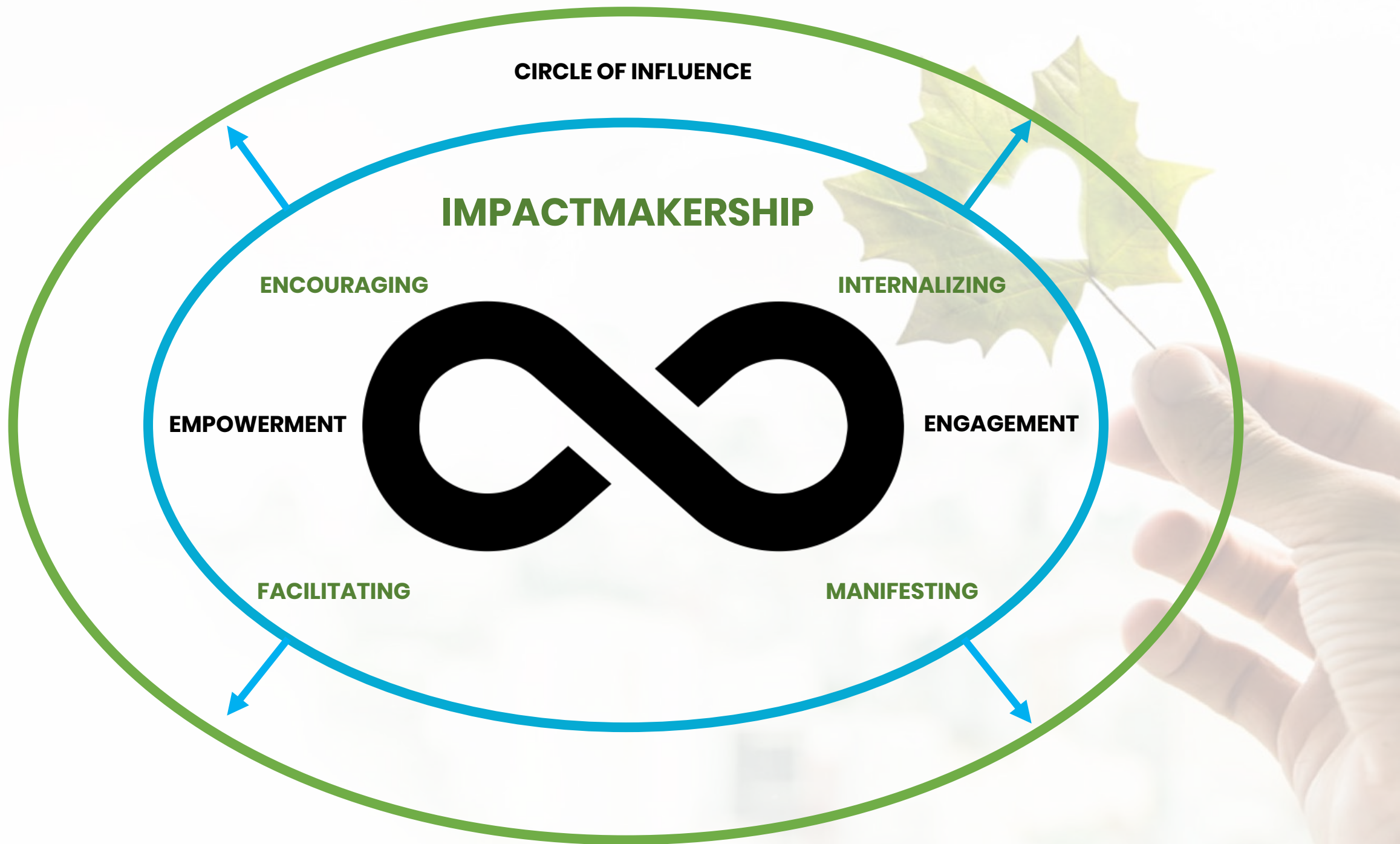


Vision
